9:00 AM - Corvettes line up on Michigan Avenue, three blocks west of the Fountain, three abreast. **First row is reserved** for Red, White and Blue Corvettes with signs honoring our Veterans. The American Legion or V.F.W. will be there to assist with the line –up. PLEASE follow their instructions.

10:00 AM - The parade proceeds east on Michigan Avenue and will disperse at the east end of Downtown, just past the Post Office.

11:00 AM (approx.) - “Unofficial Corvette Show” at the southwest corner of the K-Mart parking lot on Michigan Avenue east of I-69, after the parade.

Some Corvette Clubs will be going for lunch following the gathering in the K-Mart parking lot.
