FROM THE PRESIDENT

Drive and Dine Hints

An enjoyable and safe Drive and Dine takes some thought and planning. Based on past experiences, we have compiled some helpful hints. Begin by contacting the Social Director with the proposed date to verify that the event does not conflict with other club activities. Choose a starting point; preferably with restrooms and gasoline available. Reserve a restaurant with ample parking and accessible facilities. A flyer needs to be sent to the Editor and the Webmaster at least 30 days in advance. Bring a sign-up sheet to the club meeting with a column for a cell phone number where they can be reached the day of the event. Encourage participants to bring two-way radios.

The following are things to consider when planning a route:

- Avoid expressways and congested high traffic areas.
- A minimum of traffic lights is preferred.
- Right turns make it easier to keep the cars together.
- Avoid turns with poor sight lines or blind corners.
- Check for safe places to pull over if there are intersections where cars are likely to be separated.
- Check for major local events for that date that may create congested traffic such as festivals, parades and sports events.

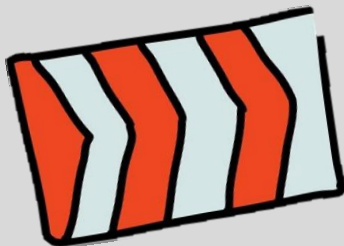


The route should be driven within 24 hours of the event to check for changes in road conditions or construction. Bring a waiver form and the sign-up sheet to the starting point. Hold a driver's meeting to cover additional information that will enhance safety and clarify the route.

Participants should arrive ahead of the driver's meeting and sign the waiver. Please call if you signed up but are unable to attend. A participant with a radio should be designated as the last car to leave the starting point. Throughout the route the lead car will be communicating with the last car in order to keep the group together. Drivers should avoid leaving large gaps between cars. They should also use their turn signals so others can follow the route.

These are some basic considerations for a safe and successful Drive and Dine. Your event can be embellished with a scenic route, a fun stopping point or a unique destination.

2 people - Primary has NCCC with another club, but spouse's NCCC is with 4C's \$50.00

2 people - Both NCCC numbers are with another club \$40.00

1 person - NCCC with another club \$30.00

I know it's confusing and some of you are wondering why some member's due's are lower than other's? Depending on the scenario you are in, depends on the amount you pay as an individual or couple and whether or not your NCCC number is with our club or another club. In short, your NCCC number and which club it is with basically determines how much you pay for your annual dues as a member.

The November meeting is also the deadline for anyone wanting to be elected for or voted for being a 2019 board member. Keep in mind too, if you do not pay your dues, you can not vote for or be elected to serve on the 2019 board. So get your dues into me.

With this being my busy time of the year as Membership Director it is greatly appreciate when all renewals are received as early as possible. This makes my job so much easier. 😊
