Reports:

Secretary: *Sandy Bechtel presented the minutes of the September 17, 2008 board meeting. Rich Bratschi moved to approve them as written. Bob Maynard seconded. Motion passed. *Based on a recent trend in some organizations, Sandy brought up the issue of whether or not we should continue to record and/or publish the names of people who present and second motions. Bob Maynard moved not to include the names of people who make and second motions in our published minutes. Carol Putmon seconded. After discussion, the motion did not pass.

Ambassador: Sandy Bechtel advised that Governor Rich Bratschi recently received information that indicates NCCC and the museum have negotiated an agreement that will allow NCCC to have a standalone display in the new addition of the museum.

Rich Bratschi, Carol Putmon, and Sandy Bechtel volunteered to be on that committee.

Editor: Chris Burke noted the deadline for submitting articles for the November newsletter is October 23, 2008.

Competition: No report.

Public Relations: Bob Maynard noted 2009 renewal letters were mailed to our current advertisers. Seven have renewed so far. Two have advised they are not renewing. Our goal is to raise \$700.00 (20 advertisers @ \$35.00 per year). We will be searching for 2-4 new advertisers to reach that goal. Bob also confirmed that Bud Kouts Chevrolet will continue to sponsor our club in 2009.

Governor/Vice President: *Rich Bratschi noted he received the ballots for the 2009 NCCC election. The ballots have been completed and will be timely mailed. *Rich noted that 2009 is the 50th anniversary of NCCC. 50th anniversary pins will cost members \$3.00. John Bechtel will send an email blast to our membership to see how many wish to purchase pins, as an order must be placed before our November general membership meeting. *Rich also advised that NCCC recently confirmed it is no

longer giving email addresses of members to sponsors. *It was agreed we will hold our 2009 low-speed event on August 15 or August 22, 2009, and apply all seven NCCC sanction points to this event. Rich will contact Spartan Speedway to reserve one of those dates.

President: John Bechtel indicated he will call for ballots to be turned in by 7:05 p.m. at the November general membership meeting. Kudos to the 2008 board for its hard work and its great spirit in serving our club.

Welcome to CCCC Frederick & Judy Koos!


Frederick & Judy recently joined our club, which they learned about from member Steve Spinrad.
