When I was a kid, visiting the Dowagiac Public Library was a real treat. The hardwood floors were a little creaky in spots, and there was always a scent of wood polish. It's a beautiful masonry structure that was built with grant money from the Andrew Carnegie Foundation. It opened in 1904, and is one of only 61 such libraries built in Michigan.

While living in Kalamazoo, my kids spent Saturday mornings at the Washington Square Library. After moving to Portage, they could walk or bicycle to a library. They loved the brown-bag story hours. Libraries instilled a love for reading and learning in them that still exists. These days, I call the Delta Township Library home.

There are a few club members that do volunteer work at libraries. For the rest of us, if you can't remember the last time you went to the library, it's been too long. You should give it a try. Walking through the doors of a library is still magical to me – it puts the whole world within reach. The "hush" that greets me is part of that magic.

Today's libraries offer services that didn't even exist when we were kids. Of course, books, reference materials, and periodicals are still available. These days, though, you can take foreign language courses, use really-speedy computers (I had to do that a couple times before I got my new one), and check out Kindles and Nooks that are preloaded with specific genres of books. There are also audio books for when you're traveling in your Corvette. The list of things available to the community seems endless. Heck, you can even check out unusually-shaped cake pans at Delta. What little grandson wouldn't love to have a Darth Vader birthday cake? One gadget you guys might find useful is an electric usage monitor you can check out. Plug an appliance into the monitor, then plug it into an outlet, and it tells you how much electricity the appliance uses. Pretty handy for knowing how much a dehumidifier, space heater, etc., is actually costing you. Who knew a library offered something like that!

Don't forget, if you prefer to buy your books, most libraries have a "Friends" book store. All the money raised helps support the library's programs. I buy a hard-bound book for \$1.50, read it, and take it back so they can sell it again. I'd say that's a win-win, wouldn't you!

So, the next time you go for a spin in your Corvette, why not stop by your local library and be amazed. Remember, "Reading is FUNdamental".

While you're at it, remember to save the wave.

News for Members

Editor's Notes:

In March I reported that *Motor Trend* magazine had the Nissan GT-R beating the Z06 in a comparo at Willow Springs race track. Well guess what, in the June issue MT retracted the results declaring it was a mistrial.

Apparently Chevrolet had furnished a Z06 with the rear suspension out of alignment. Rear caster was a positive 2 degrees instead of 0. This resulted in cornering issues which had been reported by the test driver.

Note that there were also some software changes to the suspension ride control damping in the track mode. All in all much improved reported the test driver.

The end result, the Z06 was 2.1 seconds faster. However that's only 0.7 seconds faster than the GT-R.

A retest is mostly in the works if Chevrolet has anything to say about it.
