She called us back while we were riding in the tow truck and said the people at the show were brainstorming about how they could help us. One of their members, Randy O'Neal, had his SUV at the show. He came to Heritage Chevrolet and gave us a ride to the Kalamazoo airport to pick up a rental car.

The care and concern we received from our Corvette friends that day and in the following days was a wonderful example of what that motto means. Kim and I are grateful to have survived without any injuries and thankful for the friendship of so many caring people.
