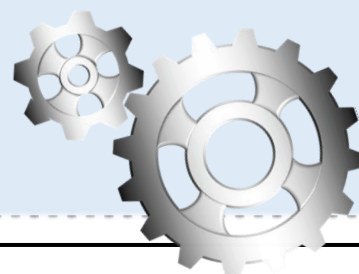

# Tech Tip

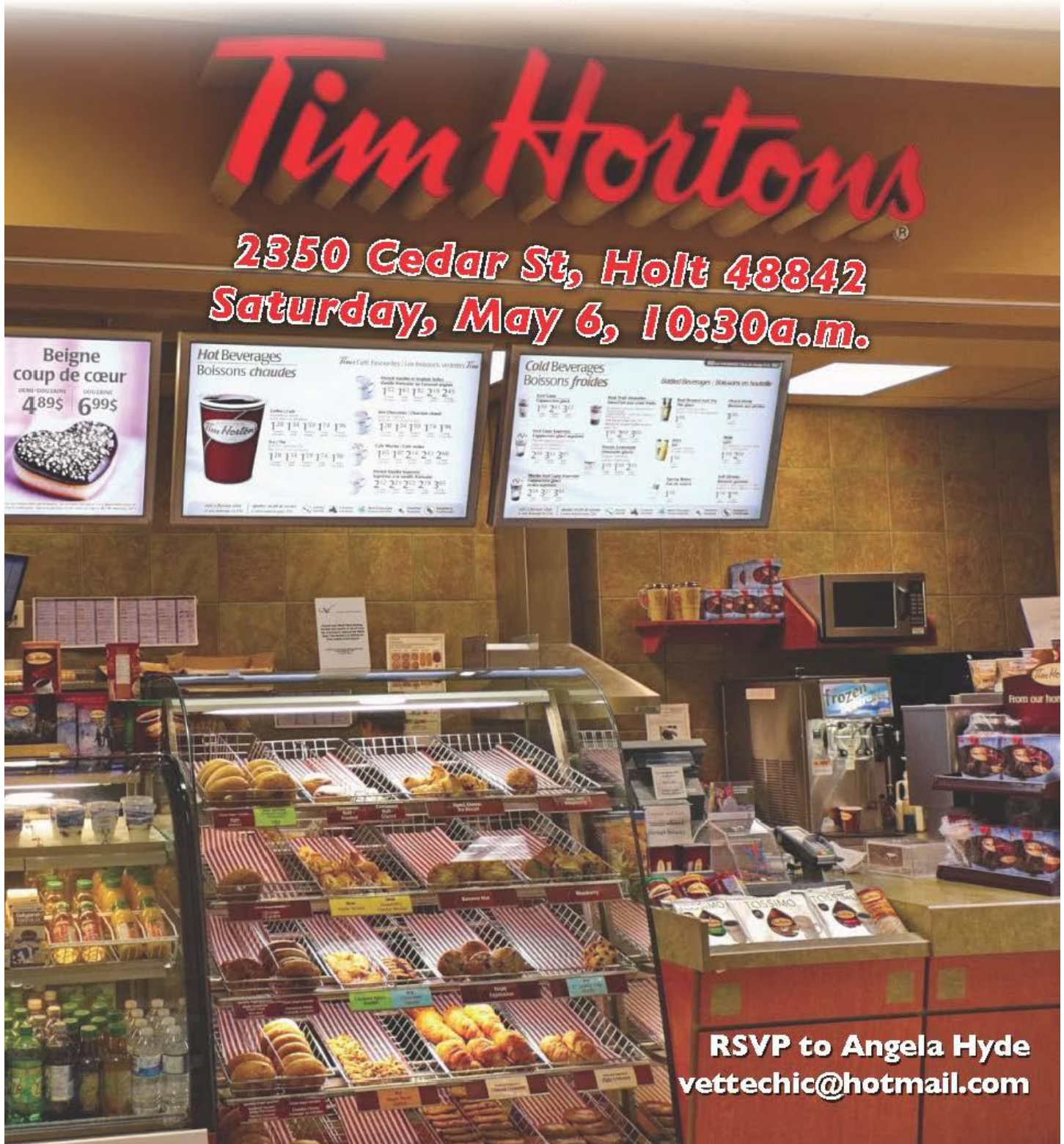

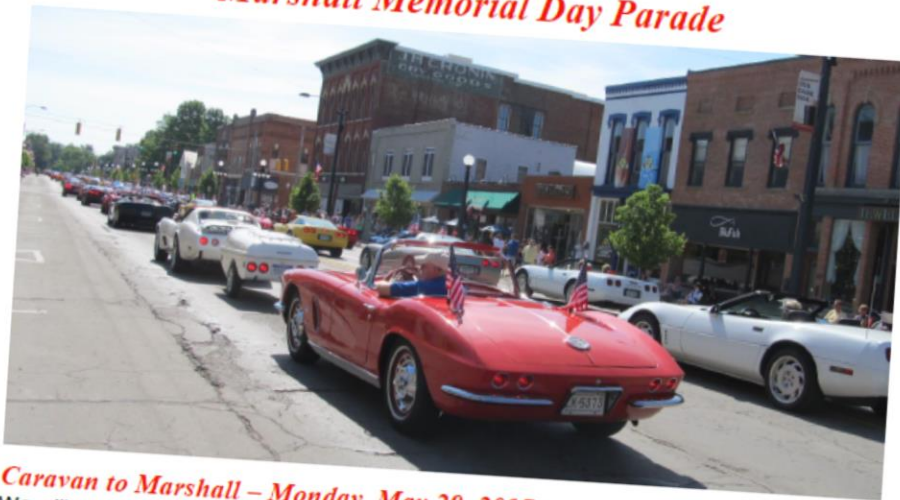

### Caravan to Marshall – Monday, May 29, 2017:

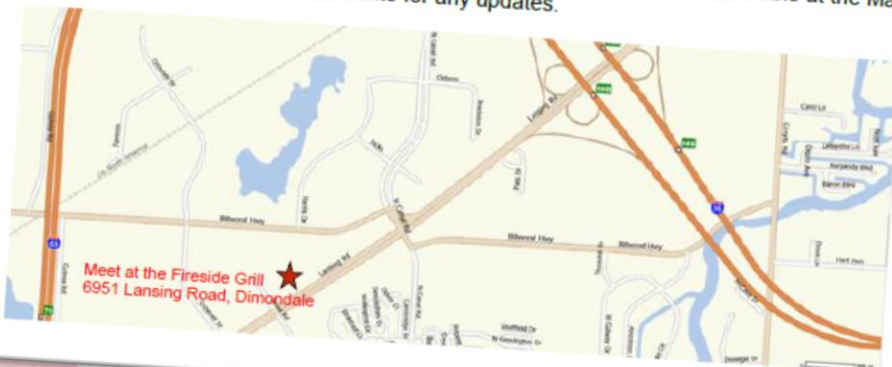

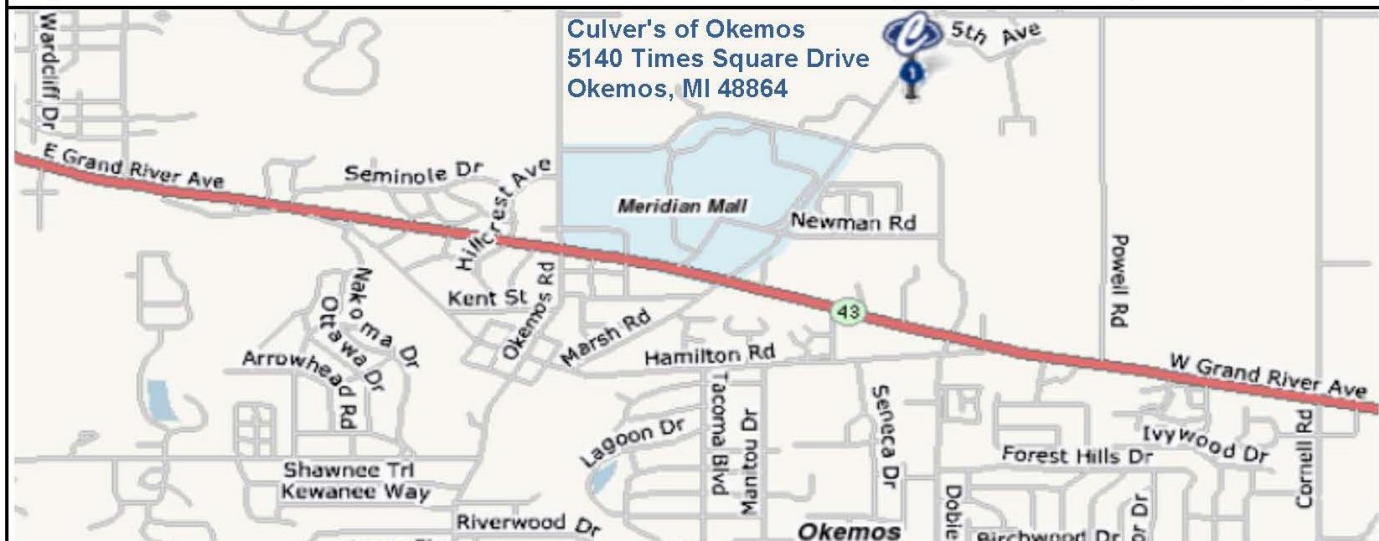

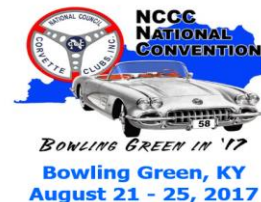
