## Foreign War Group Holds Sod-Breaking Ceremonies at Eaton Rapids.

EATON RAPIDS, Mich., Aug. 5.—

That children of men disabled in the war may not be handicapped in life by the sacrifices made by their fathers, a unique national home, sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars, is growing up on a beautiful rural site four miles southeast of Eaton Rapids.

Sunday, about 1,500 persons, members of the Department of Michigan, Veterans of Foreign Wars, their wives and children, gathered at the home for their annual picnic and to turn sod for the ninth institutional building. The group included several hundred representatives from Detroit posts. Wilber M. Brucker, attorney general, delivered the principal address.

Six buildings, housing 17 children and three widows of veterans, now comprise the home. Three more buildings are under construction and two more will be begun before the end of the summer. By the close of the year there will be 15 buildings providing facilities for 45 children. C. F. Adams, superintendent of the home, expects

### UNIQUE PLAN.

The national home is an educational experiment unique in this country. There is nothing "institutional" about the six brick residences of colonial type, built about a central park, the large barns in the background or the 612 acres of cultivated land.

Boys and girls of all ages from five weeks to 10 years live together exactly as they would in homes of their own. They are divided between the various dwellings in "age steps," duplicating as nearly as possible a family relationship.

They do not wear uniforms. At Sunday's gathering it was impossible to distinguish them from the children who had come for the day with their fathers and mothers. For these positions widows of veterans have been selected, whenever possible.

Although less than four years old, the plan already has proved a success. Originally regarded as exclusively a Michigan enterprise, the home now has become recognized by the national organization of the Veterans of Foreign Wars as its official home.

### SECOND STATE HOME.

Of the six buildings now in use two have been built from the national Poppy Fund and one each by posts in the states of Michigan, New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

The building started Sunday is the second to be donated by Michigan posts, and construction of an Illinois home will begin within a few weeks. Children now living at the home represent 14 states.

The second Michigan home will cost more than \$10,000. The sod turning ceremony Sunday was conducted by A. D. Vandervoort, of Lansing, department commander of Michigan.

Brucker, in his address, cited the need for enlarged facilities for caring for mentally disabled war veterans. The present need is for at least 200 more beds, he said.

The general appearance of the gathering of war veterans was in no way reminiscent of war. There were no uniforms. There was no so-called "vets talk." In harmony with this atmosphere, Mr. Brucker made the theme of his address a plea for peace.

### THE WILL TO PEACE.

"Merely outlawing war means no more than merely outlawing crime," he said. "As we create a public consciousness and provide police to combat crime, so must we follow up outlawing war with a will to peace and an adequate national defense."

Others taking part in the program were Dr. C. L. Candler, past state commander, and Joel R. Moore, senior department vice-commander, both of Detroit. H. N. Duff, of Lansing, senior national vice-commander, presented to the vocational school band, which took part in the program, a flag in recognition of their having recently won first place in a national contest between high school bands.

Antics of the Detroit police clown, games for the children, a turtle race and a barbecue completed the program.

In years to come, after children at the Eaton Rapids home have grown up, the present plan is to transform the buildings into an old soldiers home. Some children already are nearly at a self-supporting age. One girl has been sent to a business college and, as others are ready they will be helped toward an advanced education.

This summer some of the older boys are helping on the farm. All children over 11 have their own garden plots to care for and all have various house duties.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: all reported earlier in the meeting



We can walk into town for pancakes (or other food offerings) and still have time to visit the craft booths before heading back to our cars for the parade which starts at 3:00 p.m.




