

With summer upon us, our thoughts are on car shows, parades and days at our local in-state tracks. Speaking of tracks, I just read *Motor Trend's* article on their first look at the 2019 ZR1. What an extraordinary new vette the ZR1 is with its 755-horse power and thunderous 715 lb-ft of torque. Chevrolet claims 0 to 60 in 2.9 seconds with top speed of 212 miles per hour with the smaller rear wing and 202 with the larger wing. Can you imagine a track day at MIS with your foot on the pedal? This new ZR1 also comes in a convertible starting at \$126,095 and the coupe at \$122,095; some dealers are asking \$20,000 above the sticker price. This is a lot of car for the money when you compare it to other super cars such as the McLaren 720s starting at \$290,000 and the Lamborghini Aventador S at over \$400,000. The new ZR1 can hold its own against all the European and Japanese competitors on any track in the world. It is definitely a Corvette that every American can be proud of, especially with the upgraded leather interior.

2018 MIS Track Laps and Tours

The Track Laps and Tours dates have been set for 2018.

Bring your vehicle to MIS on August 17 or September 15 to drive around the historic two-mile oval!

Fans will have an opportunity to drive on the two-mile oval at Michigan International Speedway in their personal vehicle and then take a behind the scenes tour of the track!

Friday, August 17

- Track Tour: 2:45 p.m.
- Track Laps: 3 6 p.m.

Saturday, September 15

- Track Tour: 8:45 a.m. & 10:45 p.m.
- Track Laps: 9 a.m. 1:30 p.m.

TRACK TOUR:

Track tours will last approximately an hour and a half. Track tour tickets are \$15 each and a portion of the proceeds will benefit MIS Cares.

TRACK LAPS:

Tack laps are \$30 for five laps. A portion of the proceeds will benefit MIS Cares.

*Guests who wish to do both the Track Laps and Track Tours should purchase Track Laps tickets in a time slot that is at least 2 hours after the start of their Track Tour.

TICKETS:

Reservations for Track Tours and Track Laps can be made by calling 888-905-7223 (no online purchases are available). Once a phone order has been placed, a ticket will be mailed to the guest in advance of their selected day. All guests are asked to use the entrance off of Brooklyn Highway. You will enter the infield through the Turn 1 tunnel and park outside of the Michigan Room in the Infield Suite area.

Track Laps/Tour Guidelines:

Participants will have the opportunity to drive on the track at a maximum speed of 70 mph led by the MIS pace car. Track Laps are limited to passenger vehicles only, no motorcycles. No passing of other vehicles will be allowed at any time. The driver of the vehicle must be 21 years of age and provide a valid driver's license and proof of vehicle registration. All participants will need to sign a waiver before driving on the track. Seat-belts and headlights must be on at all times. Track tours and laps will take place in rain or shine. In the case of a date cancellation due to extreme weather or safety conditions, MIS will contact all guests in advance of their visit. Additional tickets may be available for purchase on a walk-up basis, cash only on event day.




