Members,

May is upon us and April was all to be expected in Michigan. This year I managed to drive with the top out, cut my grass twice, and wear shorts all before the last snow. From here forward it should be Corvette season!

So far, our club has held 2 events. Even without the weather cooperating, we have had a decent turn out. This brings me hope, in the face of still ever changing protocols, that we will be able to experience a more normalized summer. Unfortunately, if you review the event schedule you will notice a few events in the Michigan Region have disappeared. This was to be expected and some of the cancellations will be out of clubs' control.

As we start to take road trips and bring our Corvettes to events, now is a good time to remember to give our cars a once over to avoid unwelcome surprises. Most think to treat the gas, put the battery on a charger, and check the air pressure in the tires as we bring them out of storage. However, as cars sit over winter other items should be checked too. Belts and hoses can dry out and should be inspected. While you are checking air in the tires, don't forget to check the date. Tires age and the compounds harden over time. Even with good tread, tires should be replaced after 6 years and absolutely after 10. All fluids should be checked to be full and in good condition. Brake fluid is bad for collecting moisture and can cause corrosion inside braking components.

Hope we all get to enjoy many miles in our Corvettes this year and log some new stories with our cars.
