# President's Page



## Members,

September has just flown by. Same as last month, October has a full slate of Autocrosses and Rallyes in the region, as well as our Color Tour. If you haven't attended a regional event yet this year, I encourage you to do so this month. It is a great chance to meet new people and catch up with friends from other clubs.

October also means cooler weather. This unfortunately tells most of us soon we'll be putting our Corvettes up for winter storage. I would like to point out some items to consider to make sure your car is ready to go in the spring when you are. The first drive of the year can be as great as your expectations with a little preparation.

The gasoline in the tank is the first area of concern. With today's modern ethanol fuel, moisture can be absorbed into the fuel in addition to the fuel itself breaking down. If left untreated, this can result in poor running, fuel system failures, or a no start condition. In my research, I have found the best method to prevent moisture build up is to store the car with the tank full. This reduces the amount of air the fuel will be exposed to over the course of winter by eliminating air space in the tank. The fuel should also be treated with a stabilizer to prevent it from breaking down.

Next, and maybe just as important for your Corvette to start, is the battery. Modern cars have a constant drain on the battery for various electronic memory functions. Additionally, all batteries will lose charge over time naturally. While not only leaving you unable to get the car started without a jump, this deep discharge also reduces the life expectancy of the battery. Most car batteries are designed to deliver high amperage in short bursts and then be brought back to full charge. Best

solution here is to use a battery maintainer. They are designed to allow the battery to draw down slightly, bring it back to full charge slowly, and repeat the cycle. This keeps the battery healthy, extends life, and it will be ready for you when you turn the key in the spring.

The engine oil is another item to consider. I have heard different opinions on when to change your oil in a car that gets stored and doesn't get enough miles to see regular oil change intervals. It is best to change it at least annually if not more frequently. Since contaminates build up in the oil from the combustion process, storing with clean fresh oil is the best. Yes, some moisture content will be present in the oil at first start up, but unlike the fuel, the oil will quickly see temps over 200 degrees once the engine is running. This is more than enough to evaporate any moisture content quickly. Also, the oil is fresh and you will not have to worry about it needing to be changed, so you can drive and enjoy those first few warm(er) sunny days in the spring.

Some other items I do is to raise the tire pressure above the recommended pressure to the tires max inflation. This helps prevent flat spots. I also use mint bags in the interior to deter rodents. They last much longer than dryer sheets. If you do use dryer sheets, you should refresh them monthly. There are also bait traps set away from the car(s) in multiple locations. These should also be checked regularly and replaced if they have caught a rodent.
