



Road Trip to The Western UP

Mary and I just spent four days touring the western UP. We stayed three nights in Ontonagon and the fourth night in Munising. The first day we toured the Porcupine Mountains area. The drive to the Lake of the Clouds is nice and worth the trip. We then took South Boundary Road westward and stopped at the Overlooked Falls. Although there are several other waterfalls in the park, they are not well marked and require some hiking to get to. We did spend a couple of hours at the Presque Isle falls. The second day was spent driving up to Copper Harbor. The M41 and M26 loop north of Houghton is a beautiful drive. It reminded us of Tunnel of Trees, but much better roads. The third day, we toured Bond Falls and it's worth visiting both the lower and upper sections. After that, we headed over to Munising to do the Pictured Rocks boat tour. We recommend you pack some food and water as not much was open. Also, you'll need to have, or purchase, the Michigan parks pass to access many of the attractions.

This is the only way for Dwight to receive a tax deduction for his donation.

- The updated profits from the Birch Run Event are \$1,576.13.

- The Governor's meeting was on September 9, 2023. From the meeting: Shannon Davis the FCOA Director resigned. If anyone is interested in this position, let me know.
- From Bill Docherty, VP of Competition, the highlights of the proposed rulebook changes are:
 - 2022-R5 Allow Friday events after a Thursday holiday but no 4-day event weekends.
 - 2022-R8 Updated flyer section, removing Governor addresses and requiring only overall chair.
 - 2022-R10 Increase club sanctions from 10 to 14 per year.
 - 2023-R1 Change People's Choice Concourse to Car Show and delete paragraphs on awards and class.
 - 2023-R2 Divide Men's and Ladies standings into speed and non-speed standings. Clubs will remain as total point standings. Top 15 competitors in both speed and non-speed standings will receive awards.
- Steve Johnson, VP Membership, reported that in September 2022 we had 18,901 members, 237 clubs. We now have 19,198 members, 240 clubs.
- Walt Jenkins, Director of IT stated that 14,000 emails go out each month.
- Dale Samuelson, 2023 Convention Chair reported that the convention had 735 adults 13 youth, and 108 day passes. \$39,587.63 in profits to be split between St. Jude and NCCC. They had \$1,187 in merchandise sales.
