The Convention Directors and the Midwest Region invite you to join us in the Wisconsin Dells and Lake Delton area in the beautiful state of Wisconsin for the 66<sup>th</sup> Annual NCCC Convention August 17–22, 2025. See you there! Online Registration opens on February 1, 2025.



The Scenic Wisconsin Dells and Lake Delton area is an exciting and beautiful resort area to gather for partying as well as sightseeing, driving unique roads and exploring everything the area has to offer. Wisconsin Dells is the Water Park Capital of the World and so much more!



Wisconsin Dells is about an hour north of Madison, WI. There is plenty to see and do in the Dells and even more throughout the surrounding area. The Host Hotel will be The Kalahari Resorts & Convention Center conveniently located for all activities just off I-90/94 at Exit 92.

The Room Rate at The Kalahari will be \$156.03 including taxes and free parking. There will not be a daily resort fee. Guests will have free entry to the Tom Foolery Amusement Park as well as free use of their Indoor and Outdoor Water Parks. Entertainment, Parties and both Hosted Bus Tours and Self Guided Tours are in the planning stages. Competitive Events are being planned for 2 Rallies, 3 Drags, PC Car Show, Concours d'Elegance, Funkhana, Autocross, High Speed (not Time Trials), Scavenger Hunt, Valve Cover Races and Overall Competitor Competitions.

**I have some exciting news to share this month! We have successfully maintained our position at the top of the regional points standings, securing the number one bidding position for next year's dates at our Fall meeting. There are still 49 sanctions remaining, and the competition will be fierce. Currently, we hold a 300-point lead, but another club close behind us is utilizing multiple sanctions at the Funkhana, while we are using only one. This strategy may allow them to accumulate points, but it will also limit their earning potential in those events. If we can mobilize our racers for the final 14 events and perform well in Marshall for the post-Thanksgiving Funkhana, we will be in an excellent position. You can also earn points for our club by volunteering at any event, which will provide you with worker points. This includes helping run games and keeping score at Funkhanas and Rallies. 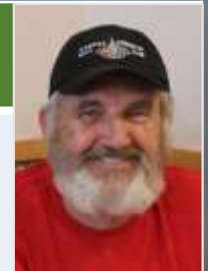

- We received information from the Annual Wisconsin Dells Corvette Adventures for 2025.
- We received a thank you from the VFW Home.
- At the meeting we had a moment of silence for deceased member Stan Olson.
- Thanks to Erick Pardo, Sandy Bechtel, and everyone else that helped with the Shaheen show.
- Thanks to Simon and Gloria for leading us to the Jackson Club Show.
- Thanks to Angela for organizing the trip to Darrell's Market Car Show.

**Secretary: Melissa Hass**

- Approval for September minutes: Motion by Kevin and seconded by Sue and approved by the majority of the members in attendance.

**Treasurer: James Sutherland**

- The books are balanced and the bills are paid.
- Stella had her staples removed today; she will not be able to participate in anything for at least 4 weeks. She does thank everyone for the cards and prayers.

**V/P Governor: Simon Reiffer**

- Gloria and I attended the Governor's Meeting last month in St. Louis. Candidates for National Offices are: President: Deb Murphy, Andy Alleshouse; VP of Membership: Sandy Arnold, Jennifer Wiegers; Treasurer: Linda Fairchild, Bernyce Molenda; Public Relations: Jeff Bruggerman and Parliamentarian: George Duncan, Bob Niznick.
- NCCC's balance sheet is down \$50,786.74 over the past year, continuing an average loss of \$50,000 per year. Only bank balances were provided. Tammy DeWitt's laptop computer crashed in the spring and she is still dealing with errors as she tries to rebuild the information in Quick Books.
- Alan Morris reported that we've had two good years with no insurance claims. There is one outstanding claim from an event prior to that.
- There is a By-Law change that we will be voting on. It is to combine the positions of Director of Charity and the Director of Sponsorship to Director of Charity and/or Sponsorship. Michele Cantelmo has been serving both positions for many years so they are looking to make it official.
- There were less than 300 in attendance at the 2024 convention. A profit of \$36,059.64 was made. The Club in Joplin was a new club and they did a great job.
- The 2025 NCCC convention will be held the week of August 17-22 at the Kalahari Resorts in the Wisconsin Dells. Registration opens on February 1<sup>st</sup>. The rate at Hillside is \$153.03 per night, including taxes, parking and resort fees. If you book for the entire week of convention, you can get the nights of August 16 and 23 at this rate. Otherwise, the fee is \$189 PLUS resort and parking fees for those days.
- Melissa Felts was at the Governor's Meeting and she did a really good job promoting the FCOA.
