June 3, 2026

VI. Announcement

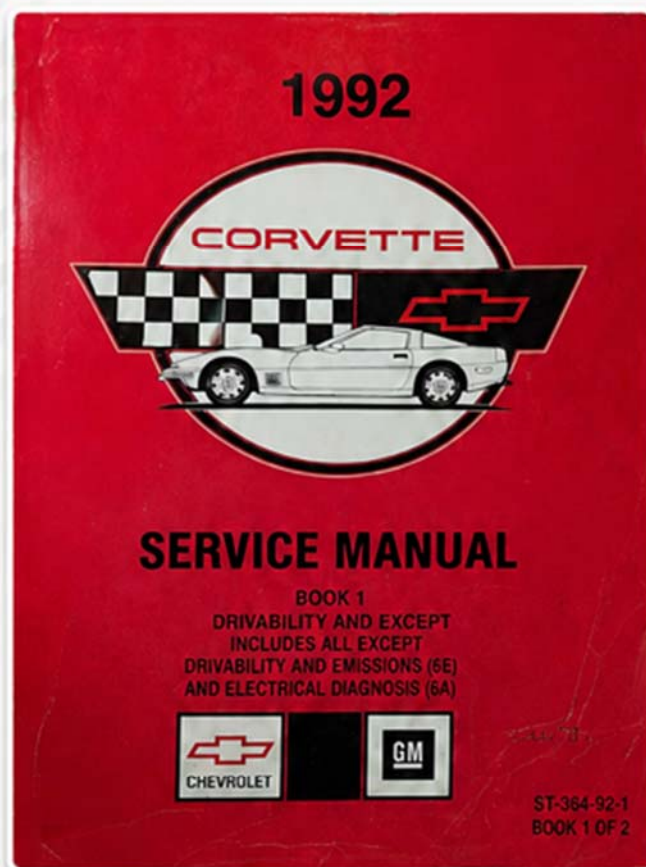
- A. Kyle Felts will be hosting a Timing Training for the Birch Run Autocross event with details to follow.
